Basis for Opinion on the Audited Consolidated Financial Results for the year ended March 31, 2023

We are independent of the Group, its joint ventures and its associates in accordance with the Code of Ethics issued by the Institute of Chartered Accountants of India ("ICAI") together with the ethical requirements that are relevant to our audit of the Consolidated Financial Results for the year ended March 31, 2023 under the provisions of the Act and the

these requirements and the Code of Ethics issued by ICAI. We believe that the audit evidence obtained by us and other auditors in terms of their report referred to in "Other Matters" paragraph below, is sufficient and appropriate to provide a basis for our audit opinion.

Management's Responsibilities for the Statement

This Statement, which includes the Consolidated Financial Results is the responsibility of the Holding Company's Management and approved by the Board of Directors for the issuance. The Consolidated Financial Results for the year ended March 31, 2023, has been compiled from the related audited consolidated financial statements. The Holding Company's Board of Directors are responsible for the preparation and presentation of these Statement for the quarter and year ended March 31, 2023 that give a true and fair view of the consolidated net profit and consolidated other comprehensive income and other financial information of the Group, its joint ventures and its associates in accordance with the recognition and measurement principles laid down in the Indian Accounting Standards prescribed under section 133 of the Act, read with relevant rules issued thereunder and other accounting principles generally accepted in India and in compliance with Regulation 33 of the Listing Regulations.

The respective Board of Directors of the companies included in the Group and of its joint ventures and associates are responsible for maintenance of adequate accounting records in accordance with the provisions of the Act for safeguarding of the assets of the Group and of its joint ventures and associates and for preventing and detecting frauds and other irregularities; selection and application of appropriate accounting policies; making judgments and estimates that are reasonable and prudent; and the design, implementation and maintenance of adequate internal financial controls, that were operating effectively for ensuring the accuracy and completeness of the accounting records, relevant to the preparation and presentation of the respective financial results that give a true and fair view and are free from material misstatement, whether due to fraud or error, which have been used for the purpose of preparation of this Consolidated Financial Results by the Directors of the Parent, as aforesaid.

In preparing the Statement, the respective Board of Directors of the companies included in the Group and of its joint ventures and associates are responsible for assessing the ability of the Group and of its joint ventures and associates to continue as a going concern, disclosing, as applicable, matters related to going concern and using the going concern basis of accounting unless the respective Board of Directors either intends to liquidate the entity or to cease operations, or has no realistic alternative but to do so.

The respective Board of Directors of the companies included in the Group and of its joint ventures and associates are responsible for overseeing the financial reporting process of the Group and of its joint ventures and associates.

Auditor's Responsibilities for the Statement

(a) Audit of the Consolidated Financial Results for the year ended March 31, 2023

Our objectives are to obtain reasonable assurance about whether the Consolidated Financial Results for the year ended March 31, 2023 as a whole are free from material misstatement, whether due to fraud or error, and to issue an auditor's report that includes our opinion. Reasonable assurance is a high level of assurance, but is not a guarantee that an audit conducted in accordance with SAs will always detect a material misstatement when it exists. Misstatements can arise from fraud or error and are considered material if, individually or in the aggregate, they could reasonably be expected to influence the economic decisions of users taken on the basis of this Consolidated Financial Results.

As part of an audit in accordance with SAs, we exercise professional judgment and maintain professional skepticism throughout the audit. We also:

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- Identify and assess the risks of material misstatement of the Annual Consolidated Financial Results, whether due to fraud or error, design and perform audit procedures responsive to those risks, and obtain audit evidence that is sufficient and appropriate to provide a basis for our opinion. - Conclude on the appropriateness of the Board of Director's use of the going concern basis of accounting and, based on the audit evidence obtained, whether a material uncertainty exists related to events or conditions that may cast significant doubt on the ability of the Group, its joint venture and its associates to continue as a going concern. If we conclude that a material uncertainty exists, we are required to draw attention in our auditor's report to the related disclosures in the Statement or, if such disclosures are inadequate, to modify our opinion. Our conclusions are based on the audit evidence obtained up to the date of our auditor's report. However, future events or conditions may cause the Group, its joint venture and its associates to cease to continue as a going concern.
- Evaluate the overall presentation, structure and content of the Statement, including the disclosures, and whether the Statement represent the underlying transactions and events in a manner that achieves fair presentation.
- Perform procedures in accordance with the circular issued by the SEBI under regulation 33(8) of Listing Regulations to the extent applicable.
- Obtain sufficient appropriate audit evidence regarding the Annual Standalone Financial Results and other financial information of the entities within the Group, its joint venture and its associates to express an opinion on the Statement. We are responsible for the direction, supervision and performance of the audit of financial information of such entities included in the consolidated financial results of which we are the independent auditors. For the other entities included in the Statement, which have been audited by other auditors, such other auditors remain responsible for the direction, supervision and performance of the audits carried out by them. We remain solely responsible for our audit opinion.

We communicate with those charged with governance of the Holding Company and such other entities included in the Statement of which we are the independent auditors regarding, among other matters, the planned scope and timing of the audit and significant audit findings, including any significant deficiencies in internal control that we identify during APADour audit.

We also provide those charged with governance with a statement that we have complied with relevant ethical requirements regarding independence, and to communicate with them all relationships and other matters that may reasonably be thought to bear on our independence, and where applicable, related safeguards.

(b) Review of the Consolidated Financial Results for the quarter ended March 31, 2023.

We Conducted our review of the Consolidated Financial Results for the quarter ended March 31, 2023 in accordance with the Standard on Review Engagements ("SRE") 2410 'Review of Interim Financial Information Performed by the Independent Auditor of the Entity', issued by the ICAI. A review of interim financial information consists of making inquiries, primarily of the Company's personnel responsible for financial and accounting matters, and applying analytical and other review procedures. A review is substantially less in scope than an audit conducted in accordance with SAs specified under section 143(10) of the Act and consequently does not enable us to obtain assurance that we would become aware of all significant matters that might be identified in an audit. Accordingly, we do not express an audit opinion.

Other Matters

(i) We did not audit the financial statements of nine subsidiaries included in the consolidated financial results, whose financial statements reflect total assets of ₹ 94,851.88 lakhs as at March 31, 2023 and total revenues of ₹ 31,048.10 lakhs and ₹ 1,14,242.26 lakhs, total net profit after tax of ₹ 3,670.64 lakhs and ₹ 13,299.23 lakhs, total comprehensive income of ₹ 3,693.02 lakhs and ₹ 13,292.86 lakhs, for the quarter ended March 31, 2023 and for the year ended March 31, 2023 respectively, and cash outflows (net) of ₹ 11,356.96 lakhs for the year ended March 31,2023, as considered in the Statement. The consolidated financial results also includes the Group's share of net profit after tax of ₹ 255.04 lakhs and ₹ 473.83 lakhs and total comprehensive income of ₹ 255.51 lakhs and ₹ 473.56 lakhs for the quarter ended March 31, 2023 and for the year ended March 31, 2023, respectively, as considered in the Statement, in respect of three associates and one joint ventures, whose audited standalone financial results have not been audited by us.

These financial statements have been audited by their respective independent auditors whose reports have been furnished to us by the Management of the Company and our opinion on the Statement, in so far as it relates to the amounts and disclosures included in respect of these subsidiaries, joint ventures and associates, is based solely on the reports of such auditors and the procedures performed by us as stated in paragraph above. Our opinion on the Statement is not modified in respect of above matters with respect to our reliance on the work done and the report of the other auditors.

(ii) The Statement also includes the standalone financial results of five subsidiaries which have not been audited by us and by any other auditor, whose unaudited standalone financial results reflect total assets of ₹ 827.27 lakhs as at March 31, 2023, total revenue of ₹ (66.91) lakhs and ₹ 9.61 lakhs, total net loss after tax of ₹ 81.52 lakhs and ₹ 148.03 lakhs and total comprehensive loss of ₹ 80.07 lakhs and ₹ 148.03 lakhs for the quarter ended and year ended March 31, 2023 respectively and net cash outflow of ₹ 481.31 lakhs for the year ended March 31, 2023 as considered in the Statement. The financial statements and financial information of such entities are unaudited and have been certified by the Management. Our opinion on the Statement in so far as it relates to five subsidiaries are based solely on such management certified unaudited financial statements. In our opinion and according to the information and explanations given to us by the Management of the Company, these financial statements are not material to the Group.



Our opinion on the Statement is not modified in respect of above matters with respect to our reliance on the work done and the report of the other auditors and the financial statement other financial information certified by the Management of the Parent.

- (iii) The Statement includes the results for the quarter ended March 31, 2023 being the balancing figure between the audited figures in respect of the full financial year and the published unaudited year to date figures up to the third quarter of the current financial year which were subject to limited review by us.
- (iv) The Comparative financial information of the company for the quarter and year ended March 31, 2022 prepared in accordance with the Ind AS included in this Statement has been audited by the predecessor auditor. The reports of the predecessor auditor on these comparative financial information dated May 19, 2022 expressed an unmodified opinion. Our report on the Statement is not modified in respect of this matter.
